

End of Key Stage Outcomes Achieved by Key Stage 2020-2021

The long term outcomes of each pupil at the end of Key Stage has been reviewed.

The charts below indicate the percentage of the outcomes that have been achieved, exceeded or not achieved. This is based on a collective assessment of the attendees at the Annual Review meeting. During the meeting a judgement is made about to what extent the outcome is achieved based on the table shown below:

Yes, a little better than the expected outcome	2
Yes, expected outcome achieved	3
Still working towards the expected outcome – excellent progress	4

Still working towards the expected outcome – a little progress	6
Maintenance of Level	7
Level Not Maintained	8

For the purposes of this analysis an outcome was considered as 'better than expected progress' if it was graded 1or2, 'expected progress' if it was graded 3-5 and 'less than expected progress' if it was graded 6-8. The expectation to this is where a pupil is experiencing a regressive condition, in which case 'maintenance of level' is considered to be 'expected progress'.


Please note: reviews were carried out throughout the pandemic though not all children were attending school regularly during this time due to shielding or parental preference.


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End of Key Stage 1 - EHCP outcomes




Comment: 11 pupils. The percentage of outcomes not achieved has dropped significantly from the analysis of 2 years ago (2018-2019 40%, 2020-2021 26%) The outcomes that pupils arrive in school with are often not framed in an achievable or realistic way and liaison with LA nurseries has gone some way to improving this. Overall 71% outcomes were achieved or exceeded.

Pupil Premium End of Key Stage 1




4 pupils at end of Key Stage 1 are in receipt of Pupil Premium and 71% of their outcomes have been achieved or exceeded their EHCP outcomes which is in line with the average overall.



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
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End of Key Stage 2 - EHCP Outcomes




Comment: At the end of Key Stage 2 77% of all pupil outcomes were met and exceeded for a total of 12 pupils. This is in line with previous years analysis.

Pupil Premium End of Key Stage 2




6 pupils at end of Key Stage 2 are in receipt of Pupil Premium and 74% of their outcomes have been achieved or exceeded their EHCP outcomes which is in line with the average overall for the Key Stage.



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
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End of Key Stage 3 - EHCP Outcomes




Comment: 14 pupils made up the end of Key Stage 3 cohort. 75% of outcomes were met and exceeded.

Pupil Premium End of Key Stage 3




6 pupils at end of Key Stage 3 are in receipt of Pupil Premium and 73% of their outcomes have been achieved or exceeded their EHCP outcomes which is in line with the average overall.



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
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End of Key Stage 4 - EHCP Outcomes




Comment: 9 pupils made up the End of Key Stage 4 cohort. 91% of outcomes were met or exceeded

Pupil Premium End of Key Stage 4




Only 3 pupils at the end of Key Stage 4 are in receipt of pupil premium. 86% of outcomes were met or exceeded which is in line for the average for the cohort.



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End of Key Stage 5 - EHCP Outcomes



At the end of Key Stage 5, and the end of their time at school 12 pupils had achieved and exceeded **93%** of the outcomes in their EHCPs

Analysis

The pupils at the end of Key Stage make very good progress towards their EHCP outcomes. The success range being from 71% - 93%. The end of Key Stage , where there has previously been concern, has improved (from 60% to 71%)

There is consistency around achievement of outcomes at the end of Key Stages 2, 3, 4 and 5 where but pleasing to note that more pupils than ever, who are moving toward the end of their school career are achieving or exceeding their outcomes. (91% at the end of KS4, 93% at the end of KS5)

Pupils in receipt of pupil premium do no worse on average than their peers who do not receive the premium.
